

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
OCTOBER 2, 2003

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners met in regular session on October 2, 2003. The following members were present: Commissioner Bid Lindsey, Mayor Allen Chapman, Commissioner Keith Durham, and Commissioner Tim Dickey. Commissioner Buford Goolsby was absent.

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Mayor Chapman to approve the minutes of the September 18, 2003 meeting, with a second by Commissioner Lindsey. Motion passed.

Mayor Chapman has as a guest Mr. Ben Luna the WLX Meteorologist. Mr. Luna is interested in politics and had visited with the Mayor for several hours today. Mayor Chapman also informed the Commission that Kraft Brothers would begin the City Audit on October 6. The Air Show at the Lawrence County Airport is this weekend, and an Art Show will be held on October 18, downtown Lawrenceburg.

Commissioner Durham informed the Commission that he had been contacted by Anne Morrow concerning the Skyliters and the Christmas Light Fund. After some discussion it was determined that the purchase would have to follow City of Lawrenceburg purchasing procedures.

A work session is scheduled for October 7, at 5:00 p.m. to discuss the City Purchasing Policy.

Attorney Betz presented 1 ordinance and 4 resolutions for consideration.

Ordinance # 971 – To amend Section 4-205 of the Lawrenceburg Municipal Code entitled “Hiring and Retention Procedures” and to amend Ordinance #825 entitled “Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of Lawrenceburg” to establish the requirement for a high school diploma or GED equivalent for all employees hired by the City of Lawrenceburg after October 17, 2003. Motion to approve on first reading was made by Mayor Chapman, with a second by Commissioner Dickey.

2003-2-10A – To reappoint John Beasley, as the City of Lawrenceburg’s representative to the Babe Ruth Board with his term to expire October 15, 2005. Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Lindsey, with a second by Commissioner Durham. Motion passed unanimously.

2003-2-10B - To enter into grant agreement with the State of Tennessee, Department of Military, Tennessee Emergency Management Agency, Contract No. Z-03-017912-00 (Disaster assistance from May 6 flood). Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Lindsey, with a second by Mayor Chapman. Motion passed unanimously.

2003-2-10C - To enter into an agreement with the American Legion (Head Start Program). Motion to approve was made by Mayor Chapman, with a second by Commissioner Lindsey. Motion passed unanimously.

2003-2-10D – To enter into an agreement with South Central Human Resource Agency (Head Start Program). Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Lindsey, with a second by Commissioner Durham. Motion passed unanimously.

With no further business to come before the Board, a motion was made by Mayor Chapman to adjourn; a second was made by Commissioner Lindsey. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.
