

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
NOVEMBER 6, 2003

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners met in regular session on November 6, 2003. The following members were present: Vice Mayor Bid Lindsey, Commissioner Keith Durham, Commissioner Tim Dickey, and Commissioner Buford Goolsby. Mayor Chapman was absent.

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dickey to approve the minutes of the October 16, 2003 meeting, with a second by Commissioner Goolsby. Motion passed.

In welcoming the press and visitors, Vice Mayor Lindsey introduced Dorsey Horne and his son Patrick Horne. Patrick is working on his Boy Scout Citizenship and Community Badge. He is a seventh grade student at E.O. Coffman.

Vice Mayor Lindsey, explained that Mayor Chapman was out of town on business. He also announced that city offices would be closed Tuesday, November 11, in observance of Veterans Day. Garbage pick-up scheduled for that day will be collected on Thursday, November 13.

Vice Mayor Lindsey, announced that Mayor Chapman asked him to announce the appointment of Bert Spearman to the Lawrenceburg Planning Commission to replace Wallace Henson, with his term to expire June 30, 2005.

There were two resolutions on the agenda for board appointments that the Commission decided to place in continuance until the next meeting when Mayor Chapman would be present.

Attorney Betz presented 1 resolution for consideration.

2003-6-11 – For the City of Lawrenceburg, Tennessee to accept the proposal and enter into a contract with Local Government Data Processing Center for the purchase of eight (8) LP Pentium IV computers, one (1) server and related hardware and software at a cost of Eighteen Thousand One Hundred Twenty Four Dollars and Thirty-four cents (\$18,124.43) to be used by the Administration Department and paid through the Series A Bond Fund. Motion to approve was made by Commissioner Dickey, with a second by Commissioner Goolsby. Motion passed unanimously.

Under Citizens Request - Ms. Gail Hughes spoke on Tourism, and the organization with which she is associated, Lawrence County Tourism. She would like for the City, County and Chamber of Commerce to add the Lawrence County Tourism web site to those organizations sites.

The Commissioners informed Ms. Hughes they would give consideration to her request.

With no further business to come before the Board, a motion was made by Commissioner Durham to adjourn; a second was made by Commissioner Goolsby. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.
