

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
APRIL 7, 2005

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners met in regular session. The following members were present: Commissioner Bid Lindsey, Commissioner Keith Durham, Commissioner Tim Dickey and Mayor Chapman. Commissioner Buford Goolsby was absent.

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Chapman made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 17th meeting, with a second by Commissioner Lindsey. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Chapman welcomed Buddy Ramsey to the Commission Meeting. Buddy is working on his Service to the Community Merit Badge for the Boy Scouts.

City Administrator Terrell Sellers reported he is continuing to work on the study for the privatization of sanitation and the outsourcing of mowing.

Attorney Betz presented 1 ordinance and 2 resolutions for consideration by the board.

Attorney Betz informed the Commission that Ordinance # 990 on the Charter Cablevision is on the agenda. The present contract with Charter is set to expire April 30, and we are not through considering their proposal. There will be a resolution next meeting to extend the present contract for 60 days to give us more opportunity to negotiate.
