

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
NOVEMBER 3, 2005

The Board of Mayor and Commissioners met in regular session. The following members were present: Commissioner Butch Morrow, Commissioner Keith Durham, and Commissioner Buford Goolsby. Commissioner Tim Dickey and Mayor Allen Chapman were absent.

With a quorum present, Vice Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Goolsby made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 20<sup>th</sup> meeting, with a second by Commissioner Morrow. Motion passed unanimously.

Vice Mayor Durham informed the Commission and citizens that city offices will be closed November 11<sup>th</sup> in observance of Veterans Day and the schedule for residential garbage pick-up over the holiday.

Ron Cato, Renee Chandler and Jody Cathy from the Utility Systems explained the reasons for the increase in gas prices and offered some information on how to conserve fuel. They also presented letters that citizens can use to contact our representatives to protest the escalation of gas prices.

Commissioner Morrow thanked the city officials, employees and the Chamber of Commerce for their participation in the reception held for the football teams competing in the 2005 Lions Crockett Bowl.

Under Legal Issues Attorney Betz presented 1 ordinance for consideration.

ORDINANCE(S)

990 - AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBERS 813, 794, 715, 714, 649, 638, 484 OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG TO ENTER INTO A NON-EXCLUSIVE CABLE TV FRANCHISE WITH CHARTER COMMUNICATIONS AND GRANTING THE RIGHT TO ERECT, MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM IN THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS, AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE FOR THE RECEPTION, TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE TELEVISION AND OTHER SIGNALS TO THE INHABITANTS OF SAID CITY, AND OTHER PURPOSES, FOR A PERIOD OF TEN (10) YEARS.

Motion to approve on second and final reading was made by Commissioner Morrow, with a second by Commissioner Goolsby. Motion passed unanimously.

With no further official business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Goolsby, with a second by Commissioner Morrow. Motion passed unanimously.
