

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
JANUARY 5, 2006

The Board of Mayor and Commissioners met in regular session. The following members were present: Commissioner Keith Durham, Commissioner Buford Goolsby, Commissioner Tim Dickey, Commissioner Butch Morrow and Mayor Allen Chapman.

With a quorum present, Mayor Chapman called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Goolsby made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 15th meeting, with a second by Commissioner Dickey. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Chapman announced the closings of City Offices in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, on Monday, January 16.

City Administrator, Terrell Sellers, informed the Commission of certain issues concerning the City of Lawrenceburg that will need to be addressed shortly.

1. The Personnel Rules and Regulations should be ready for their review by next Commission Meeting.
2. Demolition Landfill budget issues.
3. Sanitation Department deficit.
4. Boundary line dispute with Mr. Jerry Jaco

There was no official business to come before the Board, and discussions were opened in Old and New Business.

Commissioner Morrow informed the Commission that the Litter Committee will be meeting on Tuesday evenings at 6:00 p.m. in the Commission Meeting Room and invited them to attend.

He requested information on:

1. Cell phone bills – wants copy of monthly bill.
2. Amount of money spent on Storm Water project.
3. Total city debt.
4. Homeland Security funds.

Commissioner Dickey introduced items for discussion:

1. Draw up format for full time Mayor and get it on a referendum in this year's county election.
2. The purchase of new playground equipment for the new mini park.
3. The railroad spur grant project.

Commissioner Morrow invited the Commission to the Beautification Board's "Meet and Greet" for new residents in the auditorium Sunday from 2 to 4 p.m.

With no official business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Durham, with a second by Commissioner Goolsby. Motion passed unanimously.
