

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
MAY 18, 2006

The Board of Mayor and Commissioners met in regular session. The following members were present: Commissioner Buford Goolsby, Commissioner Keith Durham, Commissioner Butch Morrow, Commissioner Tim Dickey and Mayor Allen Chapman.

With a quorum present, Mayor Chapman called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Chapman made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 4<sup>th</sup> meeting, with a second by Commissioner Morrow. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Chapman announced that city offices would be closed May 29<sup>th</sup> in observance of Memorial Day, with that Monday's garbage pick-up being on Thursday, June 1. Concerning citizens using the basement at the City Administration Building during severe weather, the Mayor instructed individuals wishing to use the basement, if they found it locked to go the Police Department, hit the intercom and let dispatch know that the basement needed to be unlocked.

The Mayor also informed the Commission that May 14 through 20 is Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Week and asked for a moment of silence for fallen Police Officers.

Commissioner Morrow reminded the Commission of the Memorial Day Service at the City Administration Building on Memorial Day at 5:00 p.m.

Pat Hudgins addressed the Commission informing them of the updates and progress made at the Lawrenceburg/Lawrence County Airport, and asked for help with funding to build a new "T" Hanger that would house an additional 6 planes.

EMA Director, Joe Baxter made a presentation and gave an update on the progress of the Storm Water Project.

Commissioner Dickey revisited the speed limit on Highway 43 South, especially at the Dunn Leoma Road Intersection. Chief Shay was asked to pursue a restructuring of the speed limit from Lawrenceburg through that area.

Changes on the Lawrenceburg Board of Public Utilities were discussed and voted, the two appointments follow as resolutions.

The Public Hearing was opened for comments on Ordinance 1006, with no one wishing to make comments the Public Hearing closed.

Attorney Betz presented one ordinance and three resolutions for the Commission's consideration.

ORDINANCE(S)

1006- AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 789, ENTITLED THE "ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE". Property located on Robbins Street belonging to Bert Spearman and wife Donna from C-5 to R-2.

Commissioner Dickey made a motion to approve Ordinance 1006 on second and final reading, with a second by Commissioner Goolsby. Motion passed unanimously.
