

COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
NOVEMBER 8, 2007

The Board of Mayor and Commissioners met in regular session. The following members were present: Commissioner Butch Morrow, Commissioner Buford Goolsby, and Commissioner Robin Williams. Mayor Durham and Commissioner Moore were absent.

With a quorum present Vice Mayor Morrow called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer led by Pastor Steve Clark with Immanuel Baptist Church and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the October 25, 2007 meeting was made by Commissioner Goolsby, with a second by Commissioner Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

City attorney Betz had one ordinance and one resolution for consideration.

ORDINANCE (S)

#1033 AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG. First Reading.

Motion to approve on first reading was made by Commissioner Goolsby, with a second by Commissioner Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

RESOLUTION(S)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAM McLAIN TO SERVE AS CITY ADMINISTRATOR.

Attorney Betz asked the Commission to defer action on this resolution. Upon the attorney's request no action was taken.

A motion was made by Commissioner Williams, with a second by Commissioner Goolsby to hold the second meeting in November on the 15; as the 22 is Thanksgiving Day. Motion passed unanimously.

Vice Mayor Morrow had several announcements including the closing of city offices on the 12th of November in observance of Veterans Day and closing on the 22nd and 23rd of November in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday.

He reminded everyone of the 18th Annual Spirit of Santa Breakfast on Dec 6 & 7, the Trees of Christmas display through November 18th with Snowbird and Santa to arrive on the 17th other celebrities will tour the display on other occasions. The Veterans Day Parade on Sunday at 2 p.m., Christmas Pops, and the newly paved basketball courts at Rotary Park thanks to the Rotary Club and the David Weathers Charities.

He thanked the city employees for their fine work on the Commission Meeting room. Everyone commented on how much bigger, brighter and better it looked. He stated that we anticipate work on upgrading the auditorium to begin soon.

With no further business to come before the board a motion was made by Commissioner Goolsby to adjourn, with a second by Commissioner Williams. Motion passed unanimously.
