

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
APRIL 23, 2009

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Ronald Fox, Council Member Jerry Moore, Council Member Robin Williams, and Council Member Butch Morrow. Mayor Durham was absent.

With a quorum present Vice Mayor Morrow called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the April 9, 2009 meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

Vice Mayor Morrow asked for announcements from the Council. Council Member Williams reminded everyone of Ride Day at the Bridle and Saddle Club. Vice Mayor Morrow congratulated Mike Gladney on being named Dispatcher of the Year and complimented Beth Campbell and Sandy Calvert for everything they do for the seniors in Lawrence County and especially the Senior Olympics involving 13 counties currently being held at Rotary Park.

City Administrator William McLain introduced Michelle Banks the District Program Director for the Lawrence County Soil Conservation District. Ms. Banks informed the Council of the "Green Market" planned for the square on Saturdays 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. from the end of May until October. This Market will showcase eco friendly products as well as local produce for sale.

Mr. McLain also introduced Jayne Shaw. She gave the Council a presentation on the functions of Main Street; talked about grants and their use and matching funds. She explained to the Council that Main Street is in dire need of funding now in order to maintain its accreditation.

Mr. McLain informed the Council that Ms. Lyles has informed him she would pay \$300.00 for the property she has requested to purchase including legal fees.

The Council has placed her request on hold; to have a work session on her proposal, and other matters.
