

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
SEPTEMBER 10, 2009

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Ronald Fox, Council Member Robin Williams, Council Member Jamie Sevier, Mayor Durham and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the August 27, 2009 meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham announced several activities the Council has an opportunity to participate in this week and week-end including the Blood Mobile challenge with the county today.

City Administrator William McLain reminded the Council he needed a short work session with them after the meeting and then introduced Chief Judy Moore to give a Department Manager's report.

Chief Moore informed the Council on the many civic and public activities and meetings the Police Department participates in.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1055

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2009 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2010 AS AMENDED. Second and Final Reading.

Motion to approve Ordinance No. 1055 as amended on second and final reading was made by Council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1056

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE 2009 PROPERTY TAX RATE; TO LEVY TAXES AND TO LEVY AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL PROPERTY, REAL AND PERSONAL, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE, SUBJECT TO TAXATION. Second and Final Reading.

Motion to approve Ordinance No. 1056 on second and final reading was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Williams informed the Council that he had attended a Main Street Board of Directors Meeting and next July is the 100th Anniversary of James D. Vaughan and he asked that we help make this the only event for that week-end. This is a great heritage to be left with and we should promote it well.

With no further business to come before the Board a motion was made by Council Member Williams to adjourn with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.
