

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
November 12, 2009

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Ronald Fox, Council Member Robin Williams, Council Member Jamie Sevier, Mayor Durham and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the October 22, 2009 meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham announced the closing of city offices on November 26 and 27 in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday.

Mayor Durham informed the Council that the next meeting date will be Thanksgiving Day and we will either need to move the meeting date or cancel the meeting. Mayor Durham made a motion to cancel the last meeting in November, with a second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Sevier informed the Council that his interest in being a Council Member was to encourage the City and businesses in the city to work together to improve the economics of all. He asked Chamber President Chad Chancellor to speak on that issue.

Mr. Chancellor proceeded to inform the Council of the soon to be very aggressive drive for membership to the Chamber. He spoke on the benefits of being a member and also spoke somewhat on economic development.

City Administrator William McLain distributed several items of information requested by the Council. He also informed the Council that Mr. C. L. Overman is scheduled for the first meeting in December to discuss financing.

Mayor Durham informed the Council that the resolution concerning the agreement with the James D. Vaughan Trust would be postponed until all parties could get together to discuss conditions of the lease agreement.

City Attorney Betz had one resolution for approval.
