

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

April 9, 2015

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Moore and Council Member Sevier. Council Member Williams was absent.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Durham invited everyone to be at the Fire House Subs presentation on the square at 10 a.m. this morning.
