## COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

October 27, 2011

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Ronald Fox, Council Member Jamie Sevier, Mayor Durham, Council Member Robin Williams, and Council Member Chad Moore.

With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer led by Michael Duff and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the October 13, 2011 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Moore with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham announced the closing of city offices in honor of Veterans Day on November 11. Residential carts will be picked up Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup> for those usually picked up on Friday.

City Administrator informed the Council that the Sanitation Department is debt free having made the final payment on the last truck purchased.

Parks and Recreation Department Director, Beth Campbell reminded everyone of the Halloween Carnival at Rotary Park on October 31<sup>st</sup> from 6 to 8 pm. This event is free of charge for all citizens.

Sanitation Director, Gary Hyde explained new solid waste programs getting underway that include the recycling of glass, and staging demo – getting recycle products out of it, and creating a paint recycling program in the near future. He is also looking at new trucks that will work pick up the carts we presently own.

Council Member Moore talked about the Fire Department's t-shirts worn in October for Breast Cancer Awareness.

Lawrenceburg Utility System financials were discussed. The August and September reports were presented and all questions answered. The delay in discussion on the reports from LUS was due to conflicts with the Mayor's schedule.

City Attorney Betz presented 1 resolution for consideration by the City Council.
