

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

November 22, 2017

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Council Member Moore, Council Member Williams, and Mayor Durham. Council Member Sevier was absent.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the November 9, Regular Meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham presented retirement awards to Engr. Michael Hooper and Capt. Jeremy Johnson with the Lawrenceburg Fire Department for 20 years of service; and notified the press of the closing of city offices for Thanksgiving.

City Administrator, Chris Shaffer, informed the Council that the Driver License Renewal Center will be closed all next week due to renovations. He also listed the names of new employees Adam Slater and Jimmy Rogers to the Fire Department and Jeff Renfro and Mark Judkins to the Police Department.

Fire Chief, Jay Moore made a presentation about the structure fire on November 11, in downtown Lawrenceburg. He thanked the other Fire Departments for help as well as Police Department, Public Works and Sanitation for their assistance.

City Attorney opened the Public Hearing on Ordinance 1217. With no one wishing to address the Council concerning Ordinance 1217 the Public Hearing Closed.
