

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

August 10, 2017

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Mayor William K. Durham, Council Member Moore and Council Member Williams. Council Member Sevier was absent.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the July 13, 2017 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Fox with the amendment to the minutes to reflect he wishes to change his vote on the hiring of additional firemen. He now votes yes, as we will need more firemen, policemen and public works employees with the building of the new 4 year college. Motion to accept as amended passed unanimously.

City Administrator thanked the Chamber of Commerce for their work on the County Bicentennial Celebration and Main Street on the Vaughan Festival and the City Departments for all their assistance in these activities.

Fire Chief, Jay Moore, informed the Council of the grant and the purchase of a new "Sparky". He is being used at schools and events to teach fire prevention. He updated the Council on the events of the July Flooding and thanked the Maury County, Columbia and Hohenwald Fire Departments for their assistance.

City Attorney, Alan Betz, thanked the Parks and Public Works Department for their work on the baseball fields.

He presented a Host City award to the Mayor on behalf of Marius Bonancci by his daughter Lorraine Coryell. He was the initial creator of the Babe Ruth League.
