

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

December 27, 2012

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Robin Williams, Council Member Ronald Fox, Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Moore, and Council Member Sevier.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the December 13, 2012 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Sevier with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

The closing of city offices on January 1, 2013 was announced, as well as stating the Drivers License Testing Center will remain open as officials work with them to find a permanent solution. The local media and citizens were thanked for contacting the office of the Mayor, Senator Hensley, Representative Doss and the Office of the Governor. Your voices were heard.

City Administrator McLain introduced Garland Stone. He addressed the Council concerning the need to acquire more property for our demolition landfill.

Representatives with the Police and Fire Department updated the Council on the wreck Saturday morning in which a family was rescued from Shoal Creek and their 4 year old son has made a full recovery.

LUS Financials for November were presented, discussed and accepted.

City Attorney Betz presented 3 ordinances and 1 resolution for consideration by the City Council.
