

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

October 8, 2015

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Sevier, Council Member Williams and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the September 24, 2015 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham announced the closing of city offices on October 12 for Columbus Day; and asked the Council to set a work session for next week to discuss some of the things currently on the agenda.
