

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

September 28, 2017

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Fox, Council Member Sevier, Council Member Moore, and Council Member Williams . Mayor Durham was absent.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the September 14, 2017 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Council Member Fox to cancel the regular meeting of the board on October 12, 2017. Motion received a second from Council Member Moore. Motion passed.
