

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

August 9, 2012

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Robin Williams, Council Member Jamie Sevier, Council Member Ronald Fox, Mayor Keith Durham and Council Member Moore.

With a quorum present the Mayor called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the July 26, 2012 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Williams with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

City Administrator William McLain informed the Council that Chief Judy Moore, (absent today due to illness) has been asked to serve on the Board of Directors of the State of Tennessee Chiefs Association.

Shane Adams with the Lawrenceburg Fire Department informed the Council about a web site for "Sparky's Wish List" partnering for Fire-Safe Communities (www.sparkyswishlist.org) inviting community Partners to Support Life-Saving Fire Safety Education; allowing donations for the department to use to promote Fire Safety during Fire Prevention Week. This event is the Third Week of October each year and any donation for items for the children of the community will be greatly appreciated.

Public Works Director, Jerry Smith brought the Council up to date on the new paving technique being used. A lot of cities have visited to watch the process. Public Works will have to correct some areas, but generally very pleased with the process.

LUS Financials for the month of June were accepted.

Public Hearing on Ordinance 1101 was postponed due to time constraints.

City Attorney Betz presented 1 ordinance for consideration by the City Council.

Motion to approve on first reading was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Alan Betz thanked the Mayor and Board of Council for holding a reception for the 15 Year Old Babe Ruth All Star Team for being District 8 Champions, East Tennessee State Champions and Southeast Regional Runners Up. The event was held at the Gazebo on the Public Square.
