

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

September 12, 2013

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Moore, Council Member Williams, Council Member Sevier, Council Member Fox, and Mayor Keith Durham.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the August 22 and September 5, 2013 Special Called Council Meetings was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

Fire Chief, Jay Moore informed the Council of a new tradition the Fire Department in implementing and that being a Badge Pinning Ceremony for promotions. Tad Methvin was promoted from Captain to Battalion Chief. His parents and wife placed the pins and badge on his uniform.

Chief Moore also informed the Council that the new tower truck was used on the fire on North Military last week-end and felt the truck and the fire walls contributed to saving it and the attached buildings.

Chief Moore was complimented by the Council for an impressive 9-11 Memorial Ceremony last evening. Tyler McDow was also complimented on his work in organizing the event.

City Administrator, Chris Shaffer informed the Council of the September 16 bid opening for the grandstands as well as closing on the SunTrust Building.

Friday, September 13 at 10:00 am in Nashville, Homeland Security Awards will be presented to Terry Beecham of the Lawrenceburg Police Department and Bryan Green with the Lawrenceburg Fire Department.

We have also been approved for the TML Safety Partners Grant in the amount up to \$4,000.00. This will be a reimbursement for safety equipment already purchased

In the absence of the City Attorney Mayor Durham introduced two ordinances.

ORDINANCE NO. 1117 -AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 8-206 OF THE LAWRENCEBURG MUNICIPAL CODE TO REMOVE THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OTHER THAN BEER. Second and Final Reading

Motion to approve on second reading was made by Council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

ORDINANCE NO. 1118 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO.1016 ENTITLED BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE 2013-2014 FISCAL YEAR FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE. First Reading
Motion to approve on first reading was made by Council Member Sevier, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

LUS Financials for June and July were presented to the Council. Mayor Durham informed the Council that if they had any questions they could attend the Utilities Board Meeting.

With no further business to come before the Council a motion was made by Council Member Moore with a second by Council Member Williams to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.
