With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 8, 2012 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Moore with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

City Attorney Betz presented 1 ordinance and 3 resolutions for consideration by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 1093

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO.1081 ENTITLED BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE 2011-2012 FISCAL YEAR FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE FOR STREET LIGHTING THROUGH PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. First Reading

Motion to approve on first reading was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed to approve Ordinance No. 1093 with three aye votes and two no votes.

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH TONY'S LAWN CARE TO MOW MIMOSA CEMETERY AT THE BID PRICE OF \$500.00 PER MOWING AND TO INCLUDE CARE OF TWO FLOWERBEDS LOCATED IN THE CEMETERY.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO CONVEY PROPERTY TO MELVIN THOMAS LOCATED ON WEST TAYLOR STREET, LAWRENCEBURG, TN.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham asked Public Works Director about when he thought the First Street sidewalk and paving project would be completed. Mr. Smith indicated it should be done by the end of June.

Mayor Durham also brought about the subject of highways being abandoned by the state and being dedicated to the city; the cost of paving and maintaining those additional streets will be very expensive and should be considered in budgeting for street improvements in the future.

With no further business to come before the Council a motion was made by Council Member Moore with a second by Council Member Williams to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.
