

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG

April 14, 2011

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Mayor Keith Durham, Council Member Ronald Fox, Council Member Jerry Moore, Council Member Jamie Sevier and Council Member Robin Williams.

With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 24, 2011 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Sevier with a second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham announced the closing of city offices in observance of Good Friday on Friday April 22. Friday's residential garbage pickup will be on Thursday April 22.

City Administrator McLain broached the subject of refinance for city and utilities. The Council instructed him to shop around and negotiate for a better deal.

Thursday, April 21 at 8:30 was the time and date for the Council to begin the budget process for the fiscal year 2011-2012.

Greg Johnston addressed the Council concerning the proposal for the city to allow LCHS trap shooting team to use an area at the dog pound for practice. Mr. Johnston was not in favor of the proposal due to the amount of noise already being created there and the effect it has on his breeding horses.

There was one Ordinance and two Resolutions presented for consideration.

**ORDINANCE NO. 1074**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1065 ENTITLED BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE 2010-2011 FISCAL YEAR FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE. Second and final reading.**

Motion to approve on second and final reading was made by Council Member Williams with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

**A RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR A PORTION OF WHAT IS KNOWN AS THE CITY DOG POUND PROPERTY TO BE USED AS A TRAP SHOOTING RANGE.**

Motion to table the resolution was made by council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously. Resolution tabled.

**A RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE LAWRENCE COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INC. FOR THE OLD JAIL MUSEUM LOCATED ON WATERLOO STREET.**

Action on this resolution was deferred.

Mayor Durham asked for other comments from the Council. Council Member Sevier brought up the city codes for property upkeep and would like more teeth put in it if necessary to encourage citizens to help keep city clean.

Council Member Moore brought up LUS and stated that he is being asked a lot of questions by citizens that he can't answer and also the moral of LUS employees. He also brought up the paving of streets.

William McLain informed those present of the Memorial Day Speaker; Mr. Larry Feldhaus on May 30<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. in the city auditorium.

Department Manager Gary Hyde informed the Council that his department along with LUS and the Parks Department have an ongoing working relationship to keep the community clean; especially when they are aware that an industrial prospect is coming to visit.

With no further business to come before the Council a motion was made by Council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Sevier to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously.
