

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
October 14, 2010

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Ronald Fox, Council Member Jerry Moore, Council Member Jamie Sevier and Council Member Robin Williams. Mayor Keith Durham was absent.

With a quorum present Vice Mayor Williams called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of September 23, 2010 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Sevier with a second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

City Administrator William McLain presented a finance summary for the Council's information and informed them of the progress on the Energy Grant.

Mr. McLain asked the Council for their blessings to implement the changes suggested by Ms. Laura Jungmichel for savings in the Tennessee Risk Management Pool except for the increase in the deductible for workers comp.

The Council made a motion for Mr. McLain to implement the changes with a motion by Council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

A resolution will be presented next meeting to reflect this motion for future reference.

In old business Council Member Moore asked about the Simms Park project and Council Member Sevier mentioned his interest in seeing how the Chamber and Main Street will promote shopping at home this holiday season.

Vice Mayor Williams turned the meeting over to Attorney Betz for legal issues.

In New Business City Attorney Betz had one Ordinance for Council consideration:

TO AMEND TITLE 4 CHAPTER 15 ET SEQ OF THE LAWRENCEBURG
MUNICIPAL CODE AND ORDINANCE NUMBER 954

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AN OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND
HEALTH PROGRAM, DEVISE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND TO
PROVIDE FOR A DIRECTOR AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUCH
PROGRAM - First Reading

Motion to approve on first reading was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Fox. Motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Fox presented the Council Members handouts from the newly formed Historical Zoning Commission and read aloud their mission statement.

With no further business to come before the Council, a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.
