

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
January 28, 2010

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Jamie Sevier, Council Member Jerry Moore, Mayor Durham and Council Member Robin Williams and Council Member Ronald Fox.

With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the January 14, 2010 meeting was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham informed the Council that they were invited to a Boy Scout meeting on February 7th and the next Council Meeting we would have Leadership Lawrence County in the audience and the meeting would be held in the auditorium.

With no official business on the agenda, Mayor Durham asked City Administrator McLain to introduce items for a work session.

A discussion on the purchase of a rubber tire front end loader ensued and Mr. Baxter was given permission to rent one at this time with future discussion concerning the purchase. Mayor Durham spoke to Vic Pusser and Jerry Smith stating that Springer Road has to be redone this year, and that the School Resource Officer at the high school would like a study at the Springer Road traffic light with the purpose of eliminating traffic congestion before and after school.

Mr. McLain brought up the subject of the July 4th Celebration and asked if the City planned to sponsor other events that day. Mayor Durham felt that Civic Clubs might want to participate in the event.

Ken Hinson and Chief Judy Moore gave the Council an update on making the Animal Control Officer's job safer, and it was suggested that the Leash Law Ordinance be updated.

Council Member Sevier asked about AT&T and their new services coming to Lawrenceburg; and unanimous letters were discussed.

Council Member Moore asked Beth Campbell about the Little League Tournament.

With no further business to come before the Council, a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.
