

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
February 11, 2010

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Jamie Sevier, Council Member Jerry Moore, Mayor Durham and Council Member Robin Williams and Council Member Ronald Fox.

With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion to approve the minutes of the January 28, 2010 meeting was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham informed the Council that city offices would be closed on February 15th in observance of Presidents Day.

Mayor Durham welcomed guest as well as Leadership Lawrence County to the regular meeting of the City Council. He also informed the Council that he is in receipt of a letter from Paul Deggs with the State of Tennessee stating that the State will assist the city with the installation of the drainage under Highway 64 near the site of the previous Pyramid Restaurant.

Mayor Durham asked the Department Managers to stand and introduce themselves to the Leadership Lawrence County Class. Fire Chief Don Kelley is a member of the class this year.

City Administrator William McLain spoke to the Council concerning the amortization schedule; property maintenance – condemnation; and the status of the Energy Grant.

Attorney Betz had one resolution for consideration:

2010 - A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ATTACHED LIST OF NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS BY THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG DURING THE 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.

Attorney Betz informed the Council that he needs to change the resolution and ask the Council to take no action.

Council Member Sevier congratulated the Department Managers on the way they have handled the recent weather situations in the city, and commended them on their actions. The Department Managers received applause.

Both Mayor Durham and Council Member Williams informed the class that they were past students in Leadership and the Mayor informed them that the class was one of the influences that caused him to run for public office.

With no further business to come before the Council, a motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Sevier, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.
