

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
June 24, 2010

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session. The following members were present: Council Member Jerry Moore, Council Member Jamie Sevier, Mayor Durham, Council Member Robin Williams and Council Member Ronald Fox.

With a quorum present Mayor Durham called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of June 10 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Moore with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Durham made a presentation to Police Officer David White expressing appreciation for his service toward preserving our freedom and fighting for the freedom of others in Iraq.

Mayor Durham announced the reappointment of Mac Old, Randy Shook and Louis Brink to the Lawrenceburg Regional Planning Commission with their respective terms to expire on June 30, 2013.

Mayor Durham announced the closing of City Offices on July 5 in observance of the July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday. He reminded everyone of the activities at LCHS on Saturday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> with vendors, ball games, music and fireworks.

Mayor Durham asked Attorney Betz to give an update on the Tennessee State Championship Bar-B-Q this weekend at Rotary Park.

Street Department Manager Jerry Smith gave an update on the paving projects in his department.

Mayor Durham turned the meeting over to Attorney Betz for legal issues.

City Attorney Betz had 2 ordinances and 11 resolutions for Council consideration:

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO ACKNOWLEDGE AND  
ACCEPT THE STATE CERTIFIED TAX RATE OF \$1.4189 PER \$100 OF  
ASSESSED VALUE ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY DUE  
TO THE STATE REASSESSMENT OF PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF

Attorney Betz suggested the first resolution be withdrawn due to the fact that the state certified tax rate may be incorrect.

1065 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE  
ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2010 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2011– First  
Reading

Attorney Betz suggested the Council approve Ordinance 1065 and amend Section 11 to the corrected rate if necessary. Motion to approve on first reading amending Section 11 to the correct State Certified Tax Rate when confirmed was made by Council Member Williams, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

1066 AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE 2010 PROPERTY TAX RATE; TO LEVY TAXES AND TO LEVY AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL PROPERTY, REAL AND PERSONAL, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE, SUBJECT TO TAXATION. – First Reading

Attorney Betz suggested the Council not consider this ordinance until the correct tax rate is verified, as this ordinance is for his benefit.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Fox, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

2010-24-6E A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO APPOINT JERRY JONES TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES.

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

2010-24-6I A RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,400.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF BULLET PROOF VEST FOR POLICE OFFICERS.
