

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG  
February 23, 2023

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session.

The following members were present: Council Member Williams, Council Member Moore, and Council Member Sevier. Council Member Fox and Mayor Lay were absent.

Vice Mayor, Robin Williams conducted the meeting.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
