CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG
April 14, 2022

The Board of Mayor and Council met in regular session.

The following members were present: Mayor Lay, Council Member Sevier and Council Member Moore. Council Member Williams and Council Member Fox were absent.

With a quorum present the meeting was called to order. The meeting opened with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to approve the minutes of the March 24, 2022 Council Meeting was made by Council Member Moore with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

Michele Gantz, Main Street Director, informed the Council of a grant Main Street plans to apply for in the amount of \$250,000.00 to replace the Gazebo.

LUS Financials for February, 2022 were accepted and Director, Vic Pusser informed the Council that we did not lose any transformers during last evening storm. We had a lot of power outages due to trees and poles snapping.

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG TO ACCEPT THE GRANT FROM TENNESSEE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR HOME GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF (\$500,000) FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG TO HELP IN BRINGING THEIR HOMES UP TO CODE

Motion to approve was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed unanimously.

City Administrator, Chris Shaffer, informed the Council that we have the applications at the Municipal Building for those wishing to apply for the Home Grant which will bring their house up to code.

With no further business to come before the board motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Moore, with a second by Council Member Sevier. Motion passed.
